


Welcome to this experience we call 'worship'.

What do I need to know?

- Most importantly, you are welcome just as you are. You don't
 have to pretend to be anything you're not or behave in a certain
 way just because you are at 'church'.
- The only expectation we have is that we all respect each other, our values, our experiences, and our understandings of God.
- You are welcome to engage in as much or as little of the service as you like. If you want to stand and sing with us please do, if you would rather sit quietly, listen and watch, that is absolutely ok. You won't look weird!
- Our offering will be collected during the service it's 100% voluntary and completely up to you if you want to place any money in the collection as it comes around.
- If you need to step out at all during the service, you are welcome to we just ask that you do so discretely and quietly.
- At the rear of the church (behind the audio/visual desk) is a 'cry room' which you are welcome to use if your children (or you!) need a break.
- You can also access the toilets from the cry room.
- We continue our worship after the service over morning tea in the building behind the church at 3 Ellingworth Parade (called 'The Barn'). We would love to see you there and get to know you a bit better.
